

2019/20 LGIHA "A" Division Evaluation Process

LGIHA will be holding evaluations to determine final rosters for our Peewee & Bantam "A" teams for the upcoming 2019/20 season.

The evaluation committee will consist of the team's head coach along with a minimum of two nonaffiliated evaluators. The process will consist of 2 phases. A separate goalie evaluator may be utilized at the discretion of the coach depending on the number of tryout registrations.

The evaluation will consist of a minimum of 4 ice times with a mix of skills and scrimmages, and be broken down into two phases. Each player registered for the tryouts is guaranteed 2 ice times. Following the first two ice times (Phase 1), at the discretion of the coach and evaluators, the pool may be reduced in numbers. Following the final two ice times (Phase 2) the final roster will be set WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE COMPLETION OF THAT ICE TIME.

All releases and position offerings will be made via e-mail to the e-mail address provided on the players registration. Players who are reassigned to their respective divisions "C" team who to have feedback will be able to schedule a player meeting with the coach and a member of the evaluation committee/executive the week following final roster placement.

The final roster size is at the discretion of the head coach but cannot be less than 12 skaters and 1 goalie for Peewee and no less than 13 skaters and 1 goalie for Bantam.

Association import rules will apply to all LGIHA "A" teams. For all Rep "A" Teams, LGIHA ensures that the roster is a minimum of two-thirds Langley resident players and therefore no more than one-third players from all neighboring Female Associations.

Phase 1 appeals are available upon written request and submission of a \$100 appeal fee within 24 hours of the release e-mail **being sent**. Appeal reviews will consist of a review of the ranking scores for clerical errors as well as a panel discussion with the coach co-ordinator regarding that players scores and suitability to advance to phase 2. Should the appeal be successful the fee will be refunded. All appeal decisions are final.

Phase 2 decisions cannot be appealed.

**Please note during the evaluation skates some viewing area(s) will be restricted to evaluators and the head coach only. Family and spectators are not permitted.
